CONTRACT AGREEMENT

CONTRACT AGREEMENT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE VOICE-OVER INTERNET PROTOCOL TELECOMMUNICATION SYSTEM OF THE PHILIPPINE COMPETITION COMMISSION

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on the 13th day of April 2022 (“the Agreement”) by and between the *Philippine Competition Commission*, represented herein by its Head of Procuring Entity and OIC, Office of the Executive Director, Joseph Melvin B. Basas, with office address at 25/F Vertis North Corporate Center Tower 1, North Avenue, Quezon City (hereinafter referred to as the “Entity”), and *Terratek Business Consulting and Services*, represented herein by its President and CEO, Jonathan S. Alcartado, with office address at 440 Pureza St., Zone 043 Brgy. 425, Sta. Mesa, Manila (hereinafter referred to as the “Service Provider”) (collectively referred to herein as the “Parties”):

WHEREAS, the Entity invited bids for the *Procurement of Management Services for the Voice-Over Internet Protocol Telecommunication System of the Philippine Competition Commission* and has accepted a bid by the Service Provider, the lowest calculated bid for the sum of *Two Million One Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP2,100,000.00)*, inclusive of all applicable taxes (the “Contract Price”), and subject to contract renewal pursuant to Appendix 21 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act. No. 9184.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. The Conformed Terms of Reference;
 - b. The Supplier’s bid, including the Technical and Financial Proposals;
 - c. The Bid forms, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder’s bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents/statements submitted, including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Entity’s bid evaluation;
 - d. The Eligibility requirements, documents and/or statements;
 - e. Performance Security;
 - f. Notice of Award of Contract and the Bidder’s conforme thereto; Conditions of Contract; and
 - g. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Entity.

The Service Provider agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the Government Procurement Policy Board that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.


3. In consideration of the Contract Price, the Service Provider hereby agrees to provide to the Entity the said goods and services, complete the same and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of this Agreement.

4. The Entity hereby agrees to pay the Service Provider, in consideration of the provision of the goods and execution of the services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of this Agreement at the time and in the manner prescribed.


